




PLANT ROSSLYN: BMW Plant Rosslyn has been at the heart of BMW South Africa operations since 1973. It is the first BMW plant outside of Germany.

The BMW Group has invested more than R12.6bn into the Plant Rosslyn production facility since 1995, demonstrating the company's commitment to developing its operations in South Africa. BMW Plant Rosslyn would go on to produce 1,191,604 BMW 3 Series over five generations, before changing to BMW X3 production in 2018.

In 1999, BMW Plant Rosslyn became the first in the world to achieve certification for its integrated quality, health and safety, as well as environmental management system (ISO 9001, ISO 14001 and BS 8800).

An award-winning production facility, BMW Plant Rosslyn was bestowed Gold and Platinum honours in 2002 and 2015, respectively, in the respected J.D. Power Initial Quality Study.

More than 1,6 million vehicles have been produced at this 411,142m² Rosslyn Plant since 1973 for customers across the globe.




